The main earning sources of the organization are comes from the donation grants membership fees, vocational training center, during the year 2020-2021

We provide various vocational training to unemployment youth for income generating. We Provided care and support along with fooding, lodging, nutrition and medical facility to older person, Destitute women and children.

Create positive change in the lives of the economically under privileged and under served. Execute programs with high efficiency and minimized costs through partnerships with NGOs, likeminded organizations and government programmes. Provide multi-dimensional support for the entire family and not just for the woman .Research and develop innovative solutions to the problems of the urban poor. Programmes must meet our benchmark of "Quality & Beneficiary Satisfaction"

AREA OF OUR OPERATION:-

The project area, in which the organization has taken up, in North Dhubri, Our target area, covers the entire the State of Assam and Meghalaya. The Assam and Meghalaya are located in the North corner of India and the areas of these both states are backward and remote from all sides i.e. economically, socially, culturally etc. The communication system to these places from other states of India is very poor and so the marketing linkages also are not convenient.

Goalpara, Bongaigaon and Barpeta of Assam. The Dhubri district is situated at the North bank of the river Brahmaputra and the Kokrajhar district are in the North and Goalpara is in the east of Dhubri district. There are 11 nos. of Development Blocks in the district and nearly 1100 revenue villages under the district, besides, the organization implemented projects in the border area of Assam covering the Dhubri district. Our organization is located in the G.T.B Road, W/No.9 of Dhubri Town, which is situated in the border place of Assam. The border area of two states is very interior from all sides and the people of these areas are deprived from Govt. sponsored development activities, Voluntary efforts of Non-Govt. organization etc. In this area, The FBC is the only Voluntary organization for rendering continuous service for the poverty needy, children, women and older persons.

Governing Body Member s/ Management Committee:

The Governing Body is consisting of 8 nos. of members as per rule of the Memorandum of Association is the sole authority of the organization. The Governing Body is chaired by the President and the Secretary and they have authority to apply for various schemes, projects under Govt. and Non-Govt. agencies as per resolution of Governing. The Governing Body meeting is held Govt. and Non-Govt.

FROM THE PRESIDENT'S DESK

Social Change is constant, continuous, unavoidable and inevitable. Social transformation is the result of positive actions to improve the environment in which marginalized/afflicted/affected are assisted to progress.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE YEAR: 2020-2021

SWADHAR GREH

(Under Ministry of Women & Child Development, Govt. of India, New Delhi.)

We have been successfully running the Swadhar Greh for the destitute women from the difficult circumstances from last few years. We provide food, clothing, lodging, recreational activities, free health check up with medicines, education, vocational training and rehabilitation to the destitute women and girls those are living in difficult circumstances. We providing come generation vocational training to the Beneficiaries for their rehabilitation.



CHILD CARE INSTITUTE (SAYA CHILDREN HOME)

The organization is running a Children Home under the scheme of Integrated Child Protection Scheme (ICPS) of Govt. of India implemented through the State Child Protection Society under Social Welfare Department, Govt. of Assam.

About the Project:-

- Through this project provide shelter, both formal & non formal, counseling in residential way, formal education in regular school, games & sports, cloth and medicine to the children belonging to the age group of 6-18 years irrespective of cast, creed, sex and color. The category of beneficiaries of the project are abandoned, victim of child labour, rag pickers, orphans, beggars, trafficked and runaway children of migrant population, working and street children and other vulnerable group of children etc.
- To enhance the safety and security of children, house mothers and superintendent residing in Children's home.
- SAYA's Family like Care (FLC) provides a loving home to parentless and abandoned children to grow up within the stability and security of a family, and a supportive community. Children grow up together as brothers and sisters under the care of an SAYA's house Mother and superintendent.





"India is home to over approx 2 crore parentless and abandoned children. All too often, these children grow up on the streets – with no-one to call their own, no place to live or food to eat. Without a caring and protective parent, a child is more vulnerable to abuse, discrimination, exploitation and poverty. Their physical, psychological and social development may be hindered by insufficient nutrition, no access to education or healthcare, and lack of the emotional connection and support that every child needs".

FAMILLY COUNSELLING CENTRE:

The organization has got financial assistance from Central Social Welfare Board, under the ministry of Women & Child Development department, Govt. of India. the main services provide by us to women on Domestics violence like dowry, alcohol users demand from husband and maladjustment, mental & physical torture by husband & In-laws etc. we provide proper counseling both the party and also we provide various legal support to women with the help of different woman rights & rules of laws etc. Total number of Beneficiaries for the year 2020-2021are 157 Nos.





TARGET INTERVENTION ON HIV/AIDS:

Under Assam State Aids Control Society, we running the TI project on HIV/AIDS for Female Sex Workers and IDUs of Dhubri district of Assam, for the year 2020-2021.

About the Project:-

Intervention Package For High Risk Groups Covered Under TIs i,e

- a. Outreach and communication.
- b. Services.
- c. Creating an Enabling Environment.
- d. Community Mobilization.

Harm reduction aims to prevent the transmission of HIV by reducing the harm associated with high risk behaviours such as sharing needles, syringes and other equipment for preparing and injecting drugs, and unsafe sexual behaviors'. For this schedule we provide counseling, STI medicine to beneficiaries those are suffering from sexual Transmitted Disease (STI), counseling, BCC, advocacy, health camp, SHG formation among the female sex workers and after all we provide health education and awareness programme on HIV/AIDS. The goal is increased correct and consistent usage of condoms by FSWs/IDUs

SENIOR CITIZEN MAINTAINANCE HOME

Our organization running a Maintenance home for the senior citizens. This scheme, sanction from the Govt. of India Ministry of social justice & Empowerment, New Delhi.

About the Project

- The main objective of the Scheme is to improve the quality of life of the Senior Citizens by providing basic amenities like shelter, food, medical care and entertainment opportunities and by encouraging productive and active ageing.
- Our Vision about the Scheme:- We all have been aging since we were born and will continue to do so until death. Therefore, we all have experienced "growing" older.
- Reference to this experience, our emphasis should be on the word "growing" as opposed to "passing on in years" or some other euphemism, as there is a great difference in the implications of the terms. "Growing" refers to development, to progression and to change-which are formative experiences that should occur throughout all of our lives-while other expressions of aging relate more to passivity and inactivity.
- We admitted 18nos beneficiaries at our Care home at this year, out of these 4 nos. men and 14 nos. women.



COMPUTER & MULTILINGUAL DTP AND URDU LANGUAGE

We are running computer education and Urdu language development centre at Dhubri under national council for Promotion of Urdu Language (NCPUL). Where we provide DOEACC "O" level one year computer diploma courses with one year Urdu language certificate course for the development of the minority community in the area.

The syllabus of the course is prepared by both NCPUL and DOEACC society Chandigarh. There were 61 students of these courses.

The courses help 118 nos. youths to create self employment for their livelihood and source of income in the different parts of the district till date.



VOCATIONAL TRAINING ON TAILORING FOR WOMEN

The organizations main purpose to rehabilitate and support unemployment youths, who are suffering from various problems from the social status, who are unbearable burden of the parents as well as society. So, our organization has arranged vocational training for Unemployment Youths for free of Cost in the field of tailoring, Beauty Culture & Hair Dressing, computer. "To create an ecosystem of empowerment by skilling on a large scale at speed with high standards and to promote a culture of innovation based entrepreneurship which can generate wealth and employment so as to ensure Sustainable Livelihoods".

This year we provide vocational training to 110nos unemployment youth and out of these 45 nos.





AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON DRUGS REDUCTION

The theme of day "health for justice, justice for health" The organization has organized A Rally and Culture programme among the sisters organization with the Collaboration with Social welfare Organization of the area to observe international Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking. The objective of the program was to prevention of drug users through drug education and awareness pillar. Drug education and awareness are important because young people are faced with many influences to use both licit and illicit drugs. Education and awareness can play a counterbalancing role in shaping a normative culture of safety, moderation, and informed decision making.

Fulkumari Bapuji Club provide the service to approx 100 nos. of Injecting drugs User(IDU,s) under TI project with the help of Assam Aids Control Society. Injecting Drug Use (IDU) has emerged as an important route in the HIV transmission dynamics in India. The burden of HIV among IDUs is expanding and blood-borne infections, such as HIV, hepatitis B (HBV) and hepatitis C (HCV) are spread among IDUs primarily through risk behaviors' related to sharing of contaminated needles and syringes as well as through high risk sexual behaviors' such as unprotected sex, unsafe sex under the influence of drugs /alcohol and sex for exchange of drugs.



CHILD RECREATION ACTIVITIES & CULTURAL PROGRAMME

The organized has organized annual cultural programme yearly and different Child recreation program among the sisters organization of the area to established national integration, communal harmony, Brotherhood among the deferent cast and creed of the society.









HEALTH CHECK UP CAMPAIGN

The organization has already conducted many more IPC Health care programme for the development of the weaker sections of the society with the help of Assam State AIDS Control Society. The objective of conducting the health camp was to create awareness of general health among the people, provide general health care service and counseling them on the basic health and hygiene. Medical camps are conducted by health professionals to carry out a limited health intervention amongst the underprivileged community. Getting the appropriated kind of health checkup is vital for every human being and while considering it some important factors like age, lifestyle, family background, and risks are taken into account



NATIONAL CRECHE PROGRAMME:

We are thanks full of the ministry of Human Recourse Development, Department of women & child Development Govt of India, under Assam State Social Welfare Board, under this scheme, we Provide nutrition, free health checkup with free medicines, preeducation to the children of working mother by the help of Ayas. Each crèche centre has 25 children and two Ayas employed for looking after the children.



COMPUTER VOCATIONAL TRAINING

The organization provided free computer education to the poor students of the society, where girls are given more facility to come forward to education as our district is one of the remote, minority prone and poor area. Literate rate of this district is very low and population growth is highest in the State. So, every year we provide such computer education and out of them 30% engaged in the private sector and 25 % are engaged own business and able to developed socio-economic status of their living standard.





PLANTATION PROGRAMME

The organization regularly observed plantation day and planted various plants in the organization land for the benefitted of the inmates of the society as well as planted tree in the street side for creation atmosphere clean and to balance the nature.
